Mission Statement:

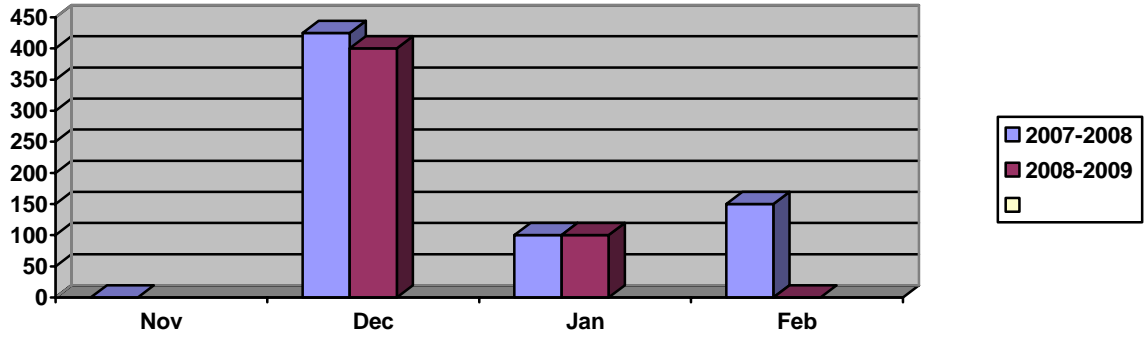
The public works employees are dedicated to provide a professional service that will improve the quality of life, safety, and appearance of the Borough of New Providence.

Here are some jobs that the Department of Public Works on a regular and recurring basis:

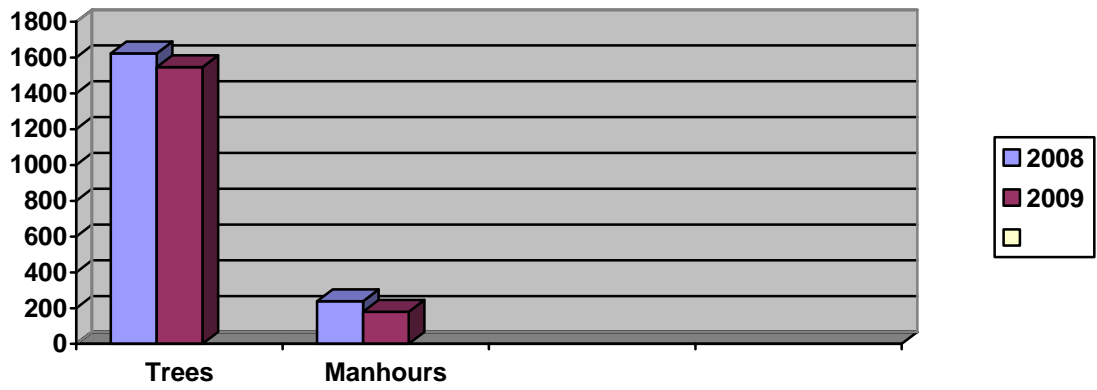
- Sign Repair

In 2009, the Department of Public Works also completed the following items, many, significant in size and scope.

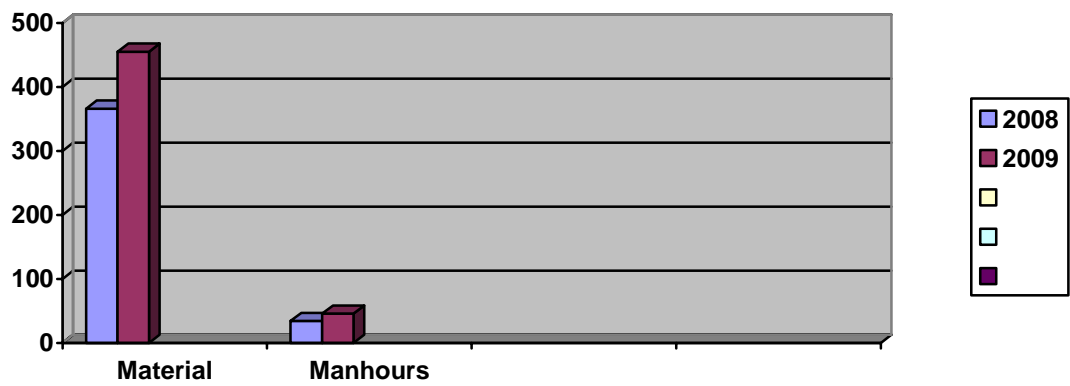
- Prepared 5 roads for paving. Installed approximately 600 tons of asphalt.
- Removed 27 dead trees.
- Installed approximately 115 new storm water plates
- Installed new drainage pipe on Candlewood Drive and storm drain
- Installed new drainage pipe on Possum Way
- Repaired several large cracks in tennis courts
- Repaired 36 catch basins
- Street sweeping. We collected 100 yards of road debris.
- Collected 6000 yards of leaves
- Maintained 105 pieces of equipment.
- Picked up 1623 Christmas trees.
- Cleaned the inside of 980 catch basins



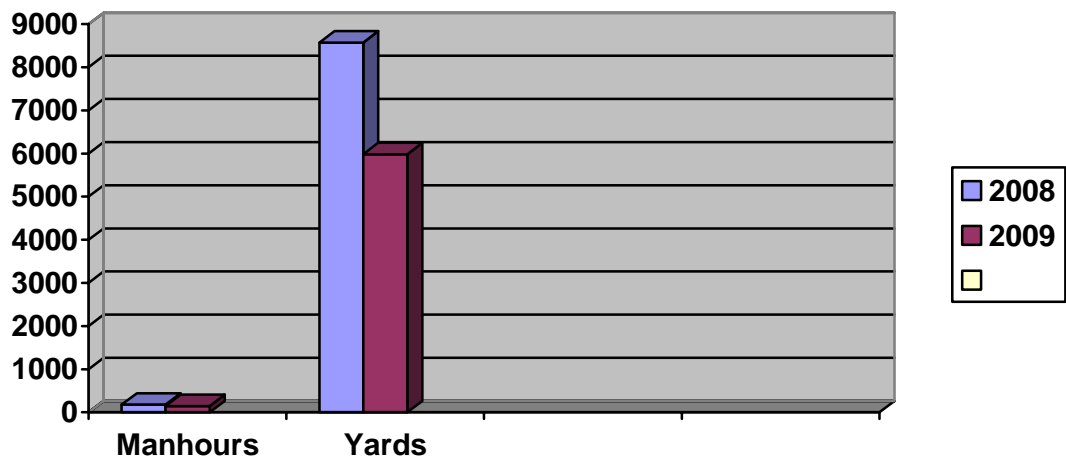
Amount of deicing material (tons) used 2008-2009
