ORDINANCE 2009-01

**“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 333 OF THE
CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW PROVIDENCE ENTITLED
‘SANITARY STANDARDS’ “**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Health of the Borough of New Providence,
County of Union and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section §333-162 of Article XXVI of the Sanitary Standards Code of the Borough Of
New Providence entitled “Sanitary Control Of Animals” is amended as follows:

Section 3. No livestock, wild or exotic animals shall be permitted or kept within the
limits of the municipality without first obtaining a permit from the Board of
Health by presenting a statement with an application for the permit. Said
permit shall be issued by the Board of Health for one (1) year for a fee of
twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per animal.
